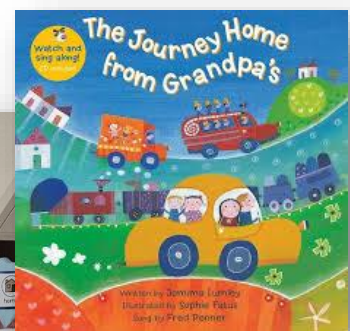
MULTIPLICATION SUCCESS
