We look forward to seeing as many of you as possible at the meeting.

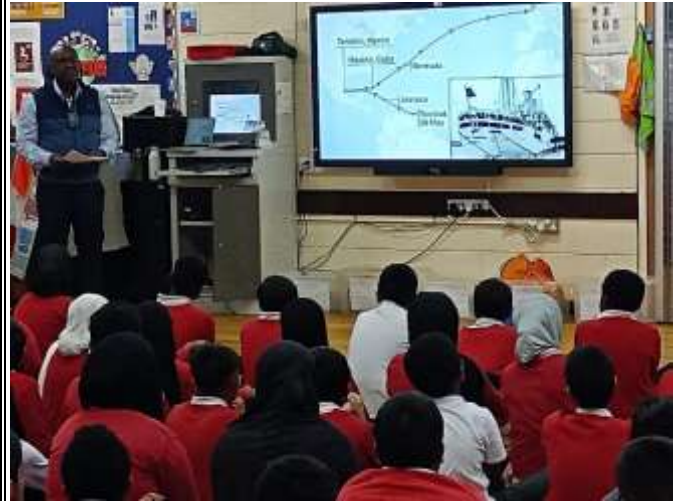
