

### **End of Year Results**

Dear Parents/Carers,

As the end of my first 6 months as Head Teacher comes to a close, I want to share with you the results we have achieved. There are some successes, many improvements from last year and areas that we want to get even better at. May I take this opportunity to thank the staff for their dedication, the pupils for their efforts and also you as parent and carers for your support.

The tables below give a summary of our statutory test results from the academic year 2023-2024. Although these results give an important marker of our performance as a school, we pride ourselves on achieving more for each of our children than just test outcomes.

Please note that this data is 'unverified'; our final (checked) data will be shared with us by the Department for Education in the Autumn term. We will update the information at this time.

The national data shared below is also currently unverified, and may change slightly from the figures quoted when national datasets are released later this year. Where National Data is not yet available, we have used 2023 National Figures; these are labelled \*.

- Birmingham residents ONLY

If eligible you will be put on the waiting list. The Early Help Central team will phone you to complete the full application. You will need to provide proof of address and any means-tested benefits.


