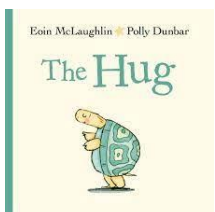
NOVEMBER INTERNET NEWSLETTER

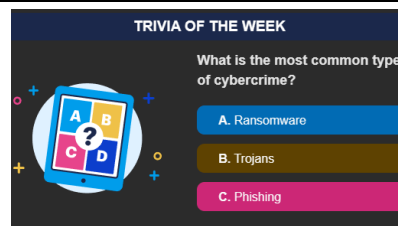
Charlie the Tortoise visited so we could collect vocabulary about what his shell felt like as we're reading the book, The Hug for our writing.



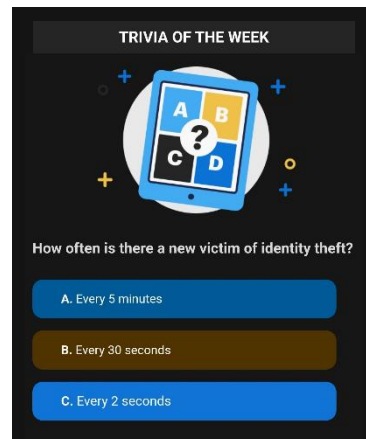

Bakers must donate £2 to enter and the cakes will be judged anonymously based on taste and appearance.

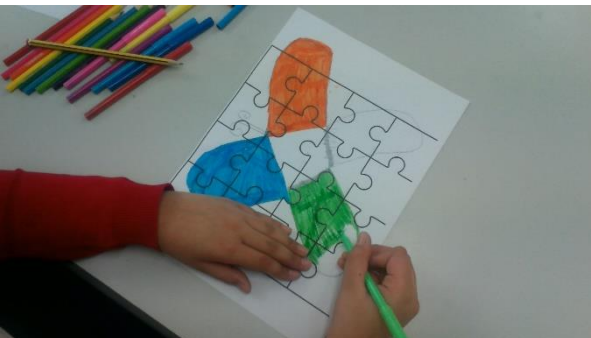
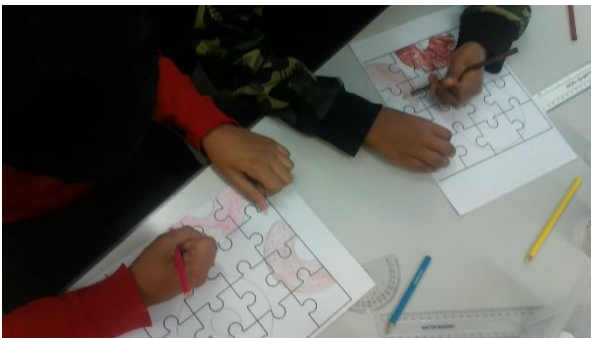
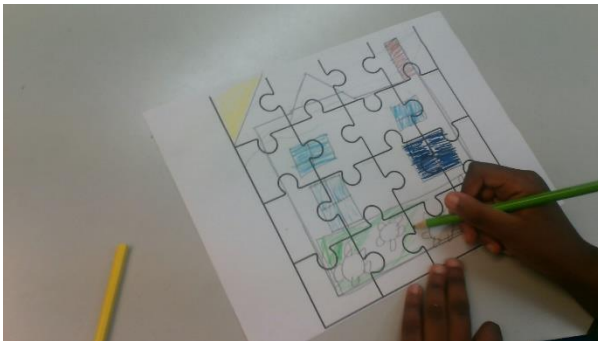
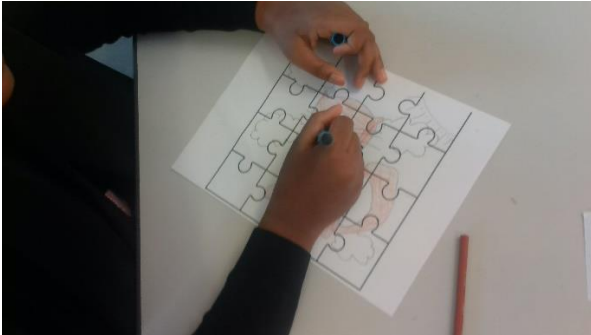
Cakes must be entered on the 16th November (by lunchtime) and then will be available to purchase on the 17th November.

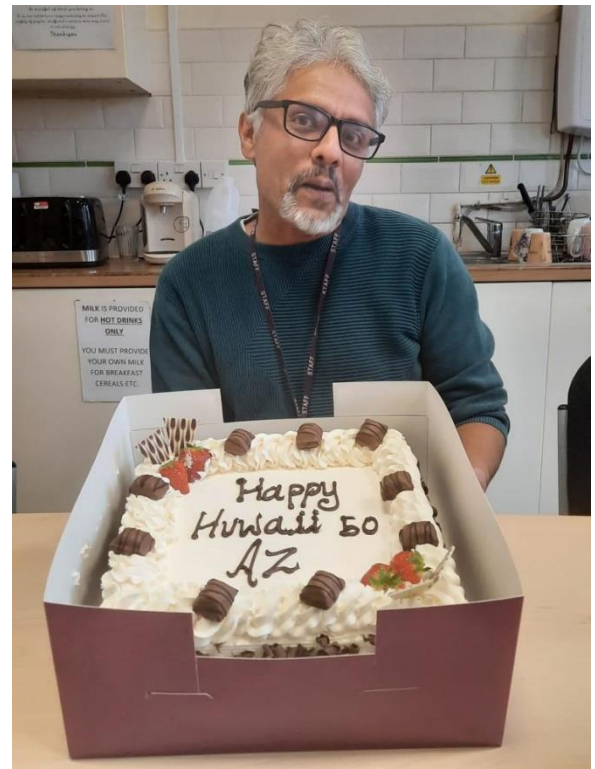

Mr Hoq tried to keep his 50th Birthday a secret, but we found out! Here he is with his 'Hawaii 50' birthday cake.

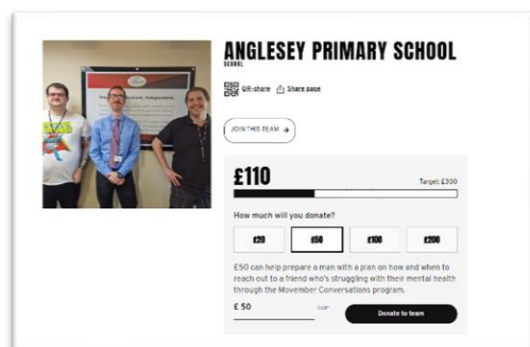
