


# NOVEMBER INTERNET NEWSLETTER

appearance.


Cakes must be entered on the 16<sup>th</sup> November (by lunchtime) and then will be available to purchase on the 17<sup>th</sup> November.


The winning baker will receive the total of the entry money as the prize.




# YEAR 6 ART CLUB

# HAPPY 50TH BIRTHDAY


Mr Hoq tried to keep his 50th Birthday a secret, but we found out! Here he is with his 'Hawaii 50' birthday cake.
