







YEAR 4

Children in year 4 have been looking at making predictions and the likelihood of certain outcomes. Our investigation this week involved rounding. We wanted to discover if we rolled dice 100's of times, overall would we be more likely to round our result up or down. Children had lots of ideas and mostly thought it was more likely our results would round up. After doing the investigation we started to spot a pattern, most of our results were rounding down. After some time, the children started to conclude that as the dice only had numbers 1-6 there were far more opportunities for the dice to round down than up.










SECONDARY SCHOOL APPLICATIONS
