A holiday brochure about visiting the city of Lima, in Peru. Independent writing should include key facts, important information, and subheadings. This term the children will be learning how to calculate the area of rectilinear shapes.

They will also be extending and consolidating their understanding of multiplication and division facts, including multiplying and dividing by 0, 1 and the number itself.

Science



Materials - Changing States

This term the children will be investigating and exploring materials, and what causes materials to change state.

They will participate in investigations where different materials are heated or cooled in order to observe, measure and record their results and conclusions.

RE



The children will learn about the celebration of Hanukah and what it symbolizes to the followers of Judaism. The children will also look at pictures and videos to show them the inside of a synagogue.

This will allow the children to identify similarities and differences between Judaism and other faiths.

Geography



The children will look at the geographical and human features of South America and identify mountain ranges, rivers forests and cities.

This will lead to a closer examination of the city of Lima, and the Basilica Cathedral in order to compare it to Birmingham and St Philips Cathedral in the city centre.

The children will learn about staying safe. They will look at fire safety, road safety and water safety. There will also be lessons on recognizing and challenging bullying behaviour.

ART and DT



In Art, the children will use paint to create landscape images.

In DT they will be looking at, designing and creating their own pneumatic toy.
