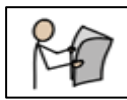


Year 4 2024 - 2025 Spring 1

And Still I rise by Maya Angelou

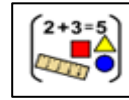
Writing



This term the children will be writing a fictional story based on an ancient Icelandic myth, which will include a hero or heroine, gods and goddesses and mythical creatures.

The children will also be writing their own poem based on 'And Still I Rise' by Maya Angelou

Maths



This term the children will be learning how to measure length in millimeters, centimeter and kilometers and how to calculate the perimeter of rectilinear shapes.

They will also be extending and consolidating their understanding of multiplication and division facts, including multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100.

Science



Materials – Electricity, Sustainability and Energy

This term the children will learn that electricity is a form of energy. They will investigate how electricity is generated and how it is used.

The children will then build electrical circuits which power light bulbs and buzzers.

RE



The children will learn that different faiths can have similar artefacts and that even though we may not follow that particular faith we must treat all artefacts with respect and tolerance.

Identify and compare religious artefacts from Sikhism, Islam, Christianity and Islam.

History



Anglo Saxons

The children will learn about the Anglo Saxons. They will understand that tribes from northern Europe invaded Britain after the Romans, shaping and changing British culture, society, laws, art and language forever.

PSHE



The children will learn about staying safe. They will look at electrical safety and fire safety. There will also be lessons on healthy relationships and mental wellbeing.

ART and DT



In Art, the children will be sketching human figures with the correct proportions. In DT they will be looking at, designing and creating their own 3D shell structures.

PE



This term the children will be dancing. They will learn how to perform individually, and in groups, creating and then following a rehearsed set of coordinated movements.

Mandarin



The children will learn how to speak common words and phrases in Mandarin. They will learn a little about the people, culture and festivals of China.

Computing



Using GarageBand software, the children will learn how to create short pieces of music. They will use iPads and laptops to research other subjects and practice times tables.

Music



The children will learn how to sing a wide variety of songs, individually and chorally, with smaller groups participating in choir, steel pans and violins.
